Royal Caribbean has delivered memorable vacations for more than 50 years. Their game-changing ships and exclusive destinations revolutionize vacations with innovations and an all-encompassing combination of experiences, from thrills and entertainment, for every type of family and vacationer.

The cruise line makes memories with adventurers across more than 300 destinations in 80 countries on all seven continents, including the line's top-rated destination, Perfect Day at CocoCay in The Bahamas.

In the 1990's, Vision-Class Ships were introduced, which are the smallest options in the fleet carrying around 2,000 passengers. These ships offer specialty restaurants and a handful of Royal Caribbean staples, such as the rock-climbing wall, Solarium adults-only pool and the line's signature steak house, Chops Grille. They spend most of their time in the Caribbean, Bermuda and Canada/New England itineraries.

In 1999, they first introduced onboard amenities on its Voyager-Class Ships, such as a rock-climbing wall, ice-skating rink and the Royal Promenade – a main boulevard of shops, restaurants and lounges that runs the length of the ship.

In 2001, the mid-size Radiance-Class Ships were introduced, which were more relaxing but offer plenty of activities and entertainment to keep everyone happy.

In 2007, they introduced the Freedom-Class Ships which feature the FlowRider surf simulator; the H20 Zone aqua park and cantilevered whirlpools suspended II2 feet above the ocean.

In 2009, Royal Caribbean revolutionized the cruise industry with the introduction of Oasis-Class Ships featuring a neighborhood concept of seven distinct themed areas, which includes Central Park, Boardwalk, the Royal Promenade, the Pool and Sports Zone, Vitality at Sea Spa & Fitness Center, Entertainment Place and Youth Zone. At full capacity, these ships can carry close to 7,000 passengers. These ships feature numerous specialty restaurants, some of the line's most innovative attractions and straight-from-Broadway shows.

In 2014, the line introduced the Quantum-Class Ships which featured unprecedented innovations in ship design, thrilling activities, game-changing technology and multidimensional entertainment. These ships hold just over 4,000 passengers.

Royal Caribbean's latest introduction is lcon-Class Ships in 2024 which broke the record of the world's biggest cruise ships. Each of the lcon vessels has been designed with seven separate pools, a water park with six waterslides, a kiddie splash zone, surfing

simulators, a miniature golf course, a basketball court and a zip line on their top deck. Inside the vessels, you'll find more lounges, bars, restaurants, shops, a casino, spas, showrooms with Broadway-style-shoes and an indoor ice-skating rink.

Together, the vessels of these seven classes — Vision, Voyager, Radiance, Freedom, Oasis, Quantum and Icon — make up Royal Caribbean's big-ship fleet.

With the addition of four new ships and the removal of two older vessels from its fleet since 2020, Royal Caribbean — the world's largest cruise line by passenger capacity — now has 28 oceangoing ships in all. 

## The many charms of Lyon, France

he charming city of Lyon, France's third-largest city, is a treasure trove of historical and cultural experiences for tourists. It is located southeast of Paris and straddles the Rhone and Saone Rivers. After Paris, it is considered the country's most significant cultural center.

Surrounded by a cityscape of redroofed buildings, tree-lined boulevards and riverside promenades, the cobblestone streets of Old Lyon host a rich collection of renaissance architecture and intimate traboules (unique passageways) that connect streets and buildings, often through courtyards.

Discover the rich history that lies throughout Lyon's charming Old Town, known as Vieux Lyon. It is one of the largest renaissance old quarters in Europe. Enjoy a funicular up to Fourviere Hill for panoramic views of the city. View the Basilica of Notre-Dame de Fourviere, a late 19th-century church built on the site of an old Roman forum. Looming over the city, the four-tower structure is fondly referred to by locals as "the upside-down elephant." From above, its shape and color resemble a giant beast on its back. This area has several attractions and museums. Continuing down the hill, stop to view the ruins of a first-century BC Roman theater, then explore the streets and shops of the Old Town.

Nestled next to the Saone River, the awe-inspiring Cathedrale Saint-Jean-Baptiste is one of the most magnificent buildings in Lyon. This cathedral, a splendid blend of Roman and Gothic styles, features a large stained-glass window and a 16th-century astronomical clock you simply can't miss. If you have never come across an astronomical clock, you're in for a real treat!

During the 15th, 16th and 17th centuries, Lyon's silk industry was thriving, and rich merchant families from across France, Flanders,

Germany and Italy settled in the city. They built sumptuous homes in the gothic, Italian renaissance and French renaissance styles, and there are still 300 of these remaining in the districts of Saint-Jean, Saint-Georges and Saint-Paules.

During the 16th century it was estimated that there were 180,000 looms in the city, and you can see the resourceful ways this industry combined with the fabric of the city in Vieux Lyon's characteristic traboules. When visiting Lyon, cap off your tour with a visit to one of the last active weaving workshops in the Old Town for an insightful demonstration.

France is renowned for its food, and Lyon is often considered the world capital of gastronomy. It is home to several original dishes and Michelinstarred restaurants. The flagship of Lyon gastronomy, Saint-Marcellin, is a cheese made from cow's milk, both sweet and creamy. It is the home city of Paul Bocuse (1926–2018), one of the most renowned French chefs in history. The city is also famous for its wine, with wine tastings and tours available in the Northern Rhone Valley or Beaujolais region.


Lyon is famed as the birthplace of film. It was here that the Lumiere brothers invented cinematography.

The most important event in Lyon's annual calendar is the Fete des Lumieres — the Festival of Lights held in December, when the whole city is lit with building facades outlined in colorful lights, a truly magical experience attracting visitors from around
